

COVID-19 PREVENTION

Limited campus access will be granted to selected groups of students to conduct laboratory experiments. This privilege is given with a clear understanding that students adhere to the following Covid-19 prevention guidelines strictly.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

At the Entrance

- Use only the Main Entrance to enter campus and follow instructions given by security staff.
- Allow the security to check your body temperature.
- **Do not enter campus if your body temperature is over 37°C.**
- **Do not enter campus if you have Covid-19 symptoms (e.g., cough, runny nose, sore throat, shortness of breath, fever, diarrhea, loss of taste, or smell).**
- **Do not enter campus if you were in contact with a suspected or known patient of COVID-19 within the last 14 days.**
- **Do not enter campus if you are suffering from immunocompromised illnesses or taking immunocompromising medication.**
- Wash your hands with soap and water at the washing station at the main entrance and disinfect your footwear using the footbath.
- It is mandatory to complete the health questionnaire on the first day of entry to SLIIT after an illness.

General Instructions

- Wearing a face mask is mandatory inside the campus.
- Students are encouraged to carry a bottle of hand sanitizer liquid for their safety.
- Practice proper respiratory etiquette always & avoid touching face, nose, eyes, etc.
- Always maintain 1m distance between each other.
- Sharing food is prohibited, and students are required to follow the health guidelines while using canteens.
- Loitering inside the campus is prohibited as access is granted primarily for academic work, and students are required to leave campus after they complete their work.

Additional instructions are posted on the SLIIT website.

Warning: Students who violate the above instructions will be given a warning in the first instance, and their id numbers will be recorded by staff. Further violations will lead to the suspension of campus access privileges for a minimum of 2 weeks and zero marks for the lab classes during the suspension.
